Over Enthusiastic Participants	If the game is booked without an operator, Entertainment Solutions advises that the client provide their own responsible adult to supervise the game.	2	1	2	With prior notice of large numbers attending the event, or if you need a trained operator, they can be supplied for an extra fee.
Damaged equipment	Staff will inspect the games before they leave the depot and at set up and throughout the event to ensure games are set up correctly and have not been damaged during use. The games must be used in accordance with the manufacturers' guidelines. The area is visually inspected by an employee before participants use the equipment. Defects are reported and taken out of use.	1	2	2	Hirer will be briefed in the safe running of the games.
Danger of unnecessary injury	Ensure no-one used the equipment who suffers from neck or back problems, heart complaints, is feeling unwell, suffering the effects of alcohol or drugs or who is pregnant	1	5	5	If any person with any of the listed conditions uses this equipment against this advice, they do so at their own risk.

Injury through lack of supervision	The most important rule of all is that the operators decision is final, refusal to abide by the operators guidance will result in game refusal and in extreme circumstances closure of the game.	2	3	6	If booked without an Entertainment Solutions Operator, please provide your own responsible person to oversee play, ensure they read this risk assessment
Injury from collision	Spectators and other players are to stand behind the players until the game is over. Sufficient space is left around game for spectators to stand at a safe distance. The game must be set up in a safe area away from the thoroughfare of guests.	1	5	5	If booked without an Entertainment Solutions Operator, please provide your own responsible person to oversee play, ensure they read this risk assessment.
Slips, trips and falls	Staff will ensure the game are set up on even ground with no potential trip obstacles in the vicinity. Platforms are a few inches above the ground. Some games have raised sides or hand rails. Any spilt liquids need to be cleared as they occur. The staff will ensure the number of participants using the games at any one time is controlled.	2	2	4	Participants MUST remove shoes with high heels before use. All children to be with a supervising adult.

L = Likelihood, S = Severity, L x S = Risk Score, with 1 = Lowest risk and 5 = Highest risk

Risk and likelihood are worked out using numbers 1 – 5. These are then multiplied to give the risk score.

Entertainment Solutions recommend that client's undertake their own risk assessment to suit individual needs.

We strive to have no risk score over 10 and anything over 20 would result in Entertainment Solutions not running the equipment.
